DEMOLITIONSUBMITTAL CHECKLIST

In accordance with Section 3303.2, Demolition, of the California Building Code (2013 Edition), the work of demolishing any building shall not commence until the required pedestrian protection structures are in place.

The City of Glendora requires the permittee to submit three sets of plans and a complete schedule for demolition. Where such plans are required, *no work shall be done until the building official approves such plans or schedule*, or both.

THREE complete sets of plans are required, including the following:

Address of Subject Property

Plot Plan - indicating structure(s) to be demolished

Pedestrian Protection Plan as per the CBC, Section 3306, when adjacent to a public way (see requirements below)

AQMD Notification (Rule 1403 Notification)

Asbestos Reports (if applicable)

Underground Service Alert Notification (DigAlert)

Water Meter Plan - contact the Engineering Division for details

Encroachment permit required when using the public right of way

SWPPP – contact the Engineering Division for details

Traffic Control Plan – contact the Engineering Division for details

When a sewer is being abandoned, a sewer abandonment permit is required

Waste Management Plan (WMP): For projects with a valuation of \$100,000 or greater, the City's Construction and Demolition Ordinance No. 1811 requires recycling of demolition, grading and construction waste. Prior to issuance of any permits, a Waste Management Plan application and fees shall be submitted to the Planning Department for review and approval.
